Recital Costume Process Begins!

In late November, we will begin measuring for recital costumes. Please make sure that your child is in attendance. We always add extra inches in order to ensure that growing room is accounted for. Often, minor alterations are still necessary. Please inquire in our office about the most convenient and cost-effective businesses that can assist you with this, should the need arise. **Please be advised your recital fee and 1st costume deposit must be paid by November 15th** for us to order your student's costumes.

Flu Season is here

Please be aware of the attendance guidelines in our studio handbook. While perfect attendance is encouraged and appreciated, the health of our dancers is of utmost importance.

PLEASE keep your child home if they have any of the following symptoms: fever, eyes that are pink, burning, itching, or producing discharge, nausea, vomiting, diarrhea, or known or suspected communicable diseases such as lice, flu, or strep throat.

Please observe the 24-hour fever free and symptom free rule before allowing your child to return to dance.


